The Zonta Club of Fort Collins was chartered in 1997 and is a member of Zonta International, a global organization of executives and professionals working together to advance the status of women as well as to empower women locally and worldwide through service and advocacy.

What makes them unique?

Zonta Club of Fort Collins was approved to create the first public historic art exhibit to display women's accomplishments and contributions to the Fort Collins community. Over 100 community members have participated to date.

Beginning in March 2020, Living Her Legacy will highlight 48 women and their accomplishments by featuring their portraits in Old Town Fort Collins, Colorado. In addition, the project includes creating curriculum from elementary to college level courses to deepen students' understanding of these women who have made a difference in our community and their personal journeys.
