Who is Florida Keys Healthy Start Coalition?

Founded in 1992, the Florida Keys Healthy Start Coalition unites people and resources to improve the health and well-being of pregnant women, children, and their families in Monroe County. They serve over 75% of the babies born in the Keys each year and support families of all economic backgrounds. Their main goal is to ensure babies are born healthy to prepared parents so that every child has a healthy start in life and continues to develop to their full potential.

What makes them unique?

Florida Keys Healthy Start Coalition team members follow families from when they first discover they are pregnant until their child reaches kindergarten, and often beyond. They view each pregnancy as a 9-month opportunity to work with pregnant women and children to ensure health before, during, and after pregnancy. Their programs are designed specifically for the expressed needs of mothers and babies in Monroe County.

Their Programs

Along with physical and mental health during pregnancy and a baby's first few years, their programs assist with care coordination and case management. They provide education and equipment addresing vehicle and bike safety, safe sleep practices, home environment, and poison safety. They facilitate family health and education workshops, developmental playgroups, and parent support groups and provide nutrition support and baby supplies such as diapers, strollers, formula, and baby food. They also provide support to parents and families who have experienced the loss of a pregnancy, baby, or child. This year they will be training community-based doulas and lactation counselors to further assist pregnant women and their families.
